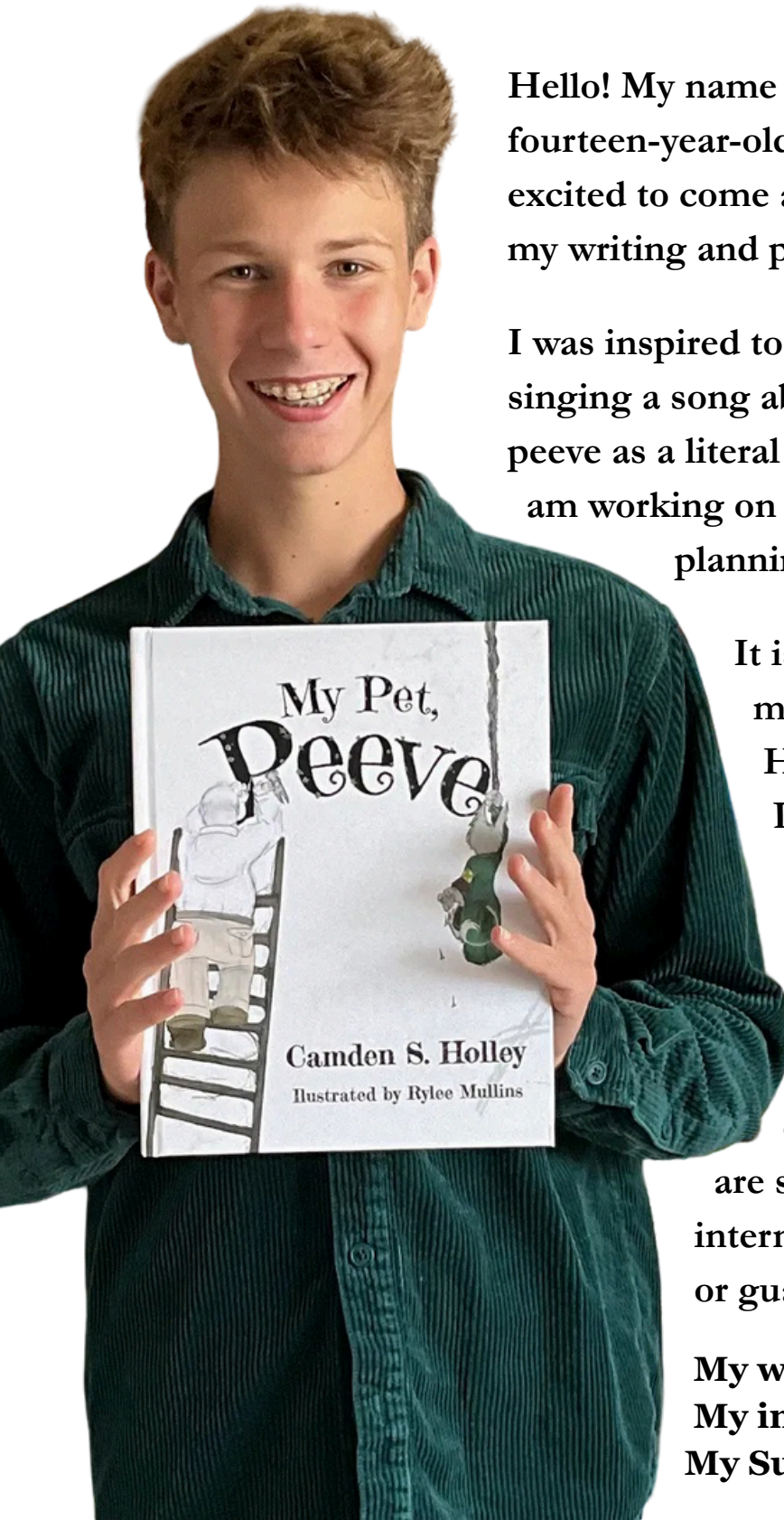
It is through children like you that I get most of my ideas and that my imprint, Holley House Books (of Igniting Souls Publishing Agency) was created.

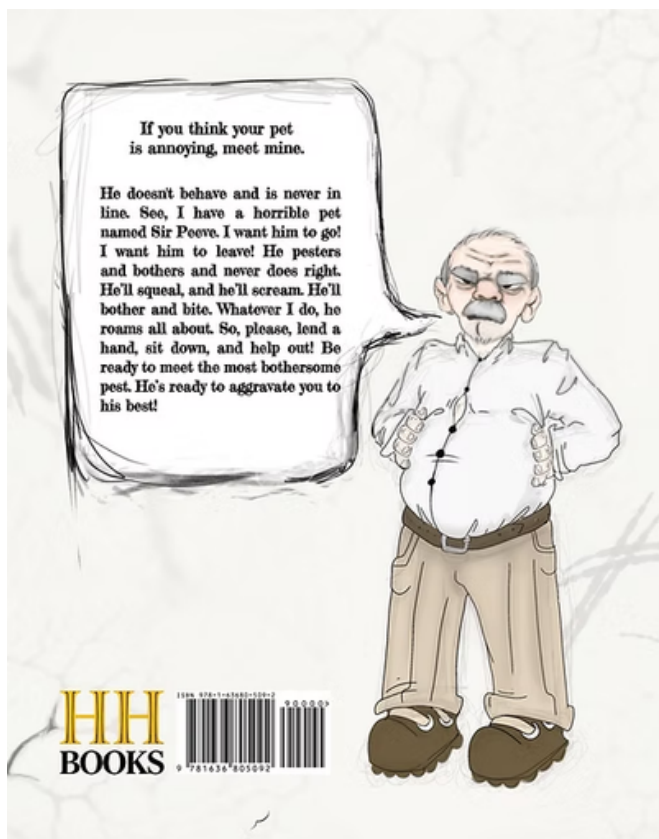
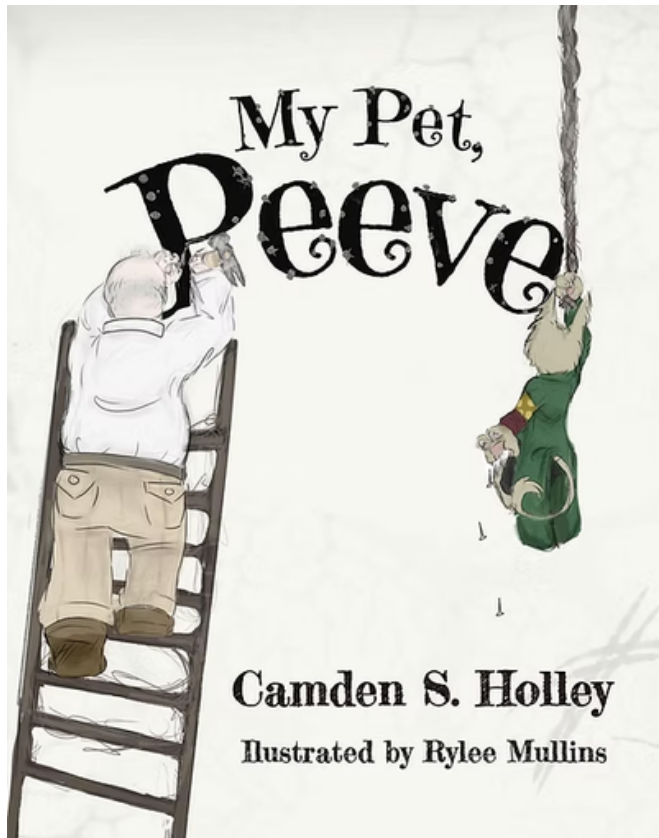
